Part One: Find your "perfect sofa"




Look for top quality materials

The materials used to make a sofa will identify its strengths and weaknesses.

Look for these features

- Top grain full aniline leather
- Fabrics abrasion tested between 30-100k double rubs
- High-Resiliency foam cushions, HR foam
- 8-way hand-tied springs
- True hardwood frames
- Mortise and tenon joinery with corner blocks
- Double-dowel joinery with corner blocks






The perfect fit: 4 things to remember

Go out and test different sofas at any furniture store. Measure 5 different styles and note your comfort experience. Use Furniture Shopping Notes to chart and compare for the perfect fit.

1. Measure seat height

Can your feet touch the ground?



2. Measure seat depth

Be comfortable.




3. Measure armheight

If you have a small space, choose a sofa with a low arm to make the room look more open.



Seat cushion options


Soft, Medium, MediumFirm, and Firm.



4 things to remember

- 1. Seat height
- 2. Seat depth
- 3. Arm height

4. Seat Cushions: Soft, Medium, MediumFirm, Firm.





Top 5 things to avoid.

Bonded leather can rub off in 2-3 years. Avoid cheap fabrics, avoid memory foam seating, avoid plywood frames, avoid sewn-on seats or back cushions.
